## **Catechism/ Faith Confession**

**Where has the sinfulness of this world come from?**

We believe that by the disobedience of Adam  
original sin has been spread through the whole human race.

**And what are the consequences of that fall of man in Adam?**

He made himself guilty and subject to physical and spiritual death  
having become wicked, perverse, and corrupt in all his ways.  
He lost all his excellent gifts which he had received from God,  
and he retained none of them except for small traces which are enough to make him inexcusable.

**Are even our very heart and nature corrupted?**

Original sin is a corruption of all nature—  
an inherited depravity which even infects small infants in their mother's womb,  
and the root which produces in man every sort of sin.

## **Is this condition so serious that it brings the judgment of God on us?**

Sin is so vile and enormous in God's sight that it is enough to condemn the human race, and it is not abolished or wholly uprooted even when one is regenerated and converted. Sin still manifests itself in the lives of God's people as though bubbling up from a contaminated spring. As the Apostle says:

I see in my members another law waging war against the law of my mind and making me captive to the law of sin that dwells in my members. For the desires of the flesh are against the Spirit, and the desires of the Spirit are against the flesh, for these are opposed to each other, to keep you from doing the things you want to do. Romans 7:23; Galatians 5:17

## **Does that mean there is no hope for us?**

This sin is not imputed to God's children for their condemnation but is forgiven by his grace and mercy. If we say we have not sinned, we make God a liar, and his word is not in us. If anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. He is the propitiation for our sins. and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin.

**The Proclamation of the Word**  
**Sermon Text- Romans 3:9-20**

<sup>9</sup> What then? Are we Jews any better off? No, not at all. For we have already charged that all, both Jews and Greeks, are under sin, <sup>10</sup> as it is written:
