**Gathering before Our God**

**Greeting**

*The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all! **And also with you!***

**Call to Worship:**

Let us give thanks to Yahweh for his righteousness.

Let us make music to praise the name of Yahweh, Most High.

***My mouth will tell of your righteous acts, of your deeds of salvation all the day, for their number is past my knowledge.***

**We are the true circumcision, who worship in the Spirit of God and glory in Christ Jesus and put no confidence in the flesh. We boast in Christ Jesus, who has become for us wisdom from God - that is, our righteousness, holiness and redemption.** (Ps. 7:17; John 4:24; Phil.3:3;1 Cor. 1:30f)

## **Confession and Assurance**

### **Call to Confession**

The Scriptures tell us "All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. [1 John 1:8f] Let us confess our sins, looking to Jesus Christ, our Savior, with faith and hope, knowing that he alone forgives and brings newness of life.

### **Prayer**

Dear God, often as your children, we start every morning determined to make it through the day without sinning; but the truth is that we don't get very far. Whether we sin by action, inaction, or in our thoughts, we are all guilty. We use this guilt to work harder, to help more people, to try to become 'holier' people. In accomplishing more, we hope to feel better about ourselves, to make You love us more and to appear more Christian than our neighbors. Forgive us, O Lord. Help us to remember that You love us because you chose us and called us to yourself. We believe in You and we are saved not because of what we do, but because of who You are and what you have done for us in the person of Your most holy Son Jesus. **Amen.**

Hear the Gospel of Christ:

***In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace.*** (1 Timothy 1:15, Ephesians 1:7)

Therefore, since we are justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

***Through him we have obtained access to this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in our hope of sharing the glory of God.*** (Rom. 5:5)

### **Confessing Our Faith in Christ Our Righteousness**

Q. What do you believe concerning the forgiveness of your sins?

*I believe that God, because of Christ's satisfaction will no longer remember any of my sins*

*or my sinful nature which I need to struggle against all my life.  
Rather, by grace God grants me the righteousness of Christ to free me forever from judgment.*

How do you come by such forgiveness?

**We are justified "freely" or "by grace" through redemption in Jesus Christ.**

**And therefore, we cling to this foundation, which is firm forever, giving all glory to God,  
humbling ourselves, and recognizing ourselves as we are;**

**not claiming a thing for ourselves or our merits and leaning and resting**

**on the sole obedience of Christ crucified, which is ours when we believe in him.** (From Heidelberg Catechism QA. 56, Belgic Confession 23)

### **Prayer of the Day**

[Adapted from the Reformed liturgy of Strasbourg by Martin Bucer (about 1540).]

**Almighty and ever gracious God, since all our salvation depends upon your holy Word: therefore grant that our hearts may be set free from worldly things, so that we may with all diligence and faith hear your Word, rightly understand your gracious will, and in all sincerity live accordingly, to your praise and glory; through our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.**

*By God alone I'm saved from my sin.*

## **The Proclamation of the Word**

### **Sermon Text- Romans 3:20-26**

<sup>20</sup> For by works of the law no human being will be justified in his sight, since through the law comes knowledge of sin. <sup>21</sup> But now the righteousness of God has been manifested apart from the law, although the Law and the Prophets bear witness to it— <sup>22</sup> the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all who believe. For there is no distinction: <sup>23</sup> for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, <sup>24</sup> and *are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus,* <sup>25</sup> whom God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith. This was to show God's righteousness, because in his divine forbearance he had passed over former sins. <sup>26</sup> It was to show his righteousness at the present time, so that he might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.

#### **Let us Confess the Mystery of Faith**

**The Word became flesh and lived among us as one of us without sin,**

**The Word is Jesus the Messiah. He said the Son of Man had come to give his life a ransom for many.**

***Christ has died,***

***Christ is risen,***

***Christ ascended,***

***Christ will come again.***

John 13:1 reads It was just before the Passover Festival. Jesus knew that the hour had come for him to leave this world and go to the Father. Having loved his own who were in the world, he loved them to the end. As a visible symbol of his love for them he instituted a new memorial meal marking the enactment of the New Covenant in the sacrifice of his blood. He gave them and all who believe through the witness of the Word of the gospel this precious holy meal For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.
